Equine Total Health Package:

Participation is voluntary. You may continue to receive your veterinary care just as you currently are. However, participation in the program affords significant savings on vaccines, parasite control and dental care.

What's included?

- Spring and Fall vaccines, Parasite Control Kit and dental care.
 - Spring vaccines include West Nile, Eastern and Western Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza and Rhino.
 - Fall vaccines include Rabies, Influenza and Rhino
 - Essential Parasite Control Kit includes 2 specimen containers for fecal checks, 1 tube of Equimax, 1 tube of Quest Plus and 1 tube of Exodus. See the attached de-worming handout. This deworming program marks a significant improvement in parasite control.
 - Fall dental care is provided at discounted pricing for participating horses, but is not billed at the time of enrollment.
- Strangles vaccination, Potomac Horse Fever vaccination and Coggins testing are not included in the package pricing, but are available upon request.
- Free Interstate Health Certificates

What's the catch?

- In this case the only thing required of you in addition to what you are already doing is that the program (spring and fall vaccines) must be paid for when you enroll in the spring.
- When you participate in our discounted program, you are also committing to use West Michigan Veterinary Service as your sole provider for vaccinations, parasite control and dental care.
- Annual enrollment in the program closes on May 31.

Who's eligible?

- Horse must reside within our practice area.
- Client account must be in good standing.
- Client agrees to follow the program recommendations.

How much will I save?

- Vaccines are discounted 5%
- Health Maintenance exam is discounted 10%
- Dewormers are discounted 10-15%
- The program price for the annual fecal is \$5.75 less than the regular cost of a fecal egg count.
- Dental care is discounted 10%

What does it benefit me?

- Significant cost savings on your horse's preventative health needs.
- Targeted and effective parasite control.
- Assurance that all of your horse's routine healthcare needs will be provided by your partnership with your veterinarian.

How do I enroll?

- When you schedule your spring appointment, let the receptionist know that you would like to participate.
- When the doctor sees your horse he will review the program and explain the Parasite Control Kit.
- You can either give payment to the doctor at the spring visit, or submit a completed credit card on file form to the business office.
